“What I can clearly see from the report is that there is a growing amount of angst among scientists of Chinese descent. Because of their heritage, scientists of Chinese descent are much more cautious about what they do and whom they work with. Given that we know how isolating the experiences of Chinese scientists are to begin with, these results indicate increased isolation and the possibility dropping out of the scientific community altogether.”
